INTRODUCTION

In 2002, the [United Nations Committee on Economic Social and Cultural Rights](#) published [General Comment No. 15](#) on the human right to water defining the right, its normative contents, and the nature of states' obligations with respect to the right.

This bibliography is a useful resource for individuals, groups, organizations, and scholars researching, promoting, or protecting the human right to water any where in the world. It is particularly useful for nongovernmental organizations working to advance the right to water and that desire to use the instrument of the law for that purpose.

The bibliography contains: information on various global, regional, and national instruments touching directly or indirectly on the human right to water; cases from various jurisdictions that touch on different aspects of that right; official reports guidelines and declarations; and scholarly articles, journals, opinions, and websites on the human right to water.

The bibliography is divided in two parts: primary and secondary sources. The primary sources are arranged in chronological order – by date of promulgation of the instruments beginning with the earliest – while the secondary sources are arranged by authors' names in alphabetical order.

The bibliography follows as much as convenient the *bluebook* uniform system of citation. But non-lawyers would find it easy to use because where available the weblinks to the resources are provided and the bluebook is accessible online for further information at <http://www.law.cornell.edu/citation/>.
